## **Response to NSW Energy Efficiency Trading Scheme Discussion Paper**

Dear Sir/Madam,

In response to the above discussion paper, I make the following comments:

- I strongly support the scheme and its attributes as outlined in your discussion paper.
- Section 4.2 – I encourage the setting of a high energy efficiency target in order to access the multitude of opportunities that exist for energy efficiency in NSW.
- Section 4.4 – I encourage the setting of a high penalty that will assist the capital cost barriers to energy efficiency.
- Section 5.1 – I suggest the inclusion of a DAF for lighting change-outs in the commercial, industrial and outdoor lighting sectors. For example for T5, LED, metal halide and high pressure sodium light sources.
- Section 5.1 – I suggest the inclusion of a DAF for change over of 50W downlights to lower power light sources, for example 35W halogen, compact fluorescent and LED replacements.
- Section 5.1 – I suggest the inclusion of a DAF to encourage fuel switching from electricity to other sources such as gas and solar (e.g. for water heating, space heating and cooking).

Thank you for the opportunity to comment. I look forward to the introduction of a successful Energy Efficiency Trading Scheme.
