# Alignment with GGAS, VEET & REES

- Seek to align activities, activity definitions and evidentiary requirements
- Straightforward where activities only in one other scheme
- Stakeholder preferences sought where differences between schemes
- Will develop NSW specific DAF values

# BASIX Plus

- BASIX
  - For new homes and major renovations
  - Sets mandatory minimum energy efficiency requirements
  - Non-prescriptive outcomes based tool
- Potential for a Project impact assessment approach where requirements are exceeded
- Will scope for second iteration of the Rule
