WATER MANAGEMENT ACT 2000
Order under section 59 (1) (a)

AVAILABLE WATER DETERMINATION
Brisbane Water, Mooney Mooney Creek, Mangrove Creek, Wyong River,
Tuggerah Lakes Water Sources

Various categories of access licences

PURSUANT to section 59 (1) (a) of the *Water Management Act 2000*, I, DAVID HARRISS, having delegated authority from the Minister for Water, do, by this Order, make a determination as to the availability of water in relation to the water sources specified in Schedule 1, for the categories and subcategories of access licence specified in Schedules 2 and 3, on the terms specified in Schedules 2 and 3.

The amount of water to be credited to a water allocation account in accordance with this available water determination is to be reduced by the amount of any water in the account in the current water year, and prior to the making of this Order, by reason of clause 25 of Schedule 10 to the *Water Management Act 2000*.

This Order takes effect on the 1st August 2009.

SCHEDULE 1

This Order applies to the following water sources as identified in the *Water Sharing Plan for the Central Coast Unregulated Water Sources 2009*:

1. Brisbane Water Water Source;
2. Mooney Mooney Creek Water Source;
3. Mangrove Creek Water Source;
4. Wyong River Water Source; and
5. Tuggerah Lakes Water Source.
