WATER MANAGEMENT ACT 2000
Order under section 59 (1) (a)

AVAILABLE WATER DETERMINATION
Hunter Regulated River Water Source

Various categories/ subcategories of access licence

PURSUANT to section 59 (1) (a) of the *Water Management Act 2000*, I, DAVID HARRISS, having delegated authority from the Minister for Water, do, by this Order, make a determination as to the availability of water in relation to the water source specified in Schedule 1, for the categories and subcategories of access licence specified in Schedules 2 and 3, on the terms specified in Schedules 2 and 3.

This Order takes effect on the 1st July 2009.

SCHEDULE 1

This Order applies to the:

1. Hunter Regulated River Water Source (as defined in the *Water Sharing Plan for the Hunter Regulated River Water Source 2003*).

SCHEDULE 2

Each amount specified in Column 2 applies to the adjacent category or subcategory of access licence specified in Column 1.

| Category/ subcategory of access licence | Volume per unit of access licence share component |
| Regulated river (high security) access licences | 1.0 megalitre |
| Regulated river (general security) access licences | 1.0 megalitre |
| Supplementary water access licences | 0.1 megalitre |

Each amount specified in Column 2 applies to the adjacent category or subcategory of access licence specified in Column 1.

| Category/ subcategory of access licence | Percentage per megalitre of access licence share component |
| Domestic and stock access licences | 100% |
| Local water utility access licences | 100% |
| Major utility access licences | 100% |

Note: (1) An available water determination made in relation to a particular category of access licence applies to all subcategories of that category, except to the extent to which this order provides otherwise, in accordance with section 59 (1A) of the *Water Management Act 2000*.

(2) Licence holders are reminded that they are only permitted to take supplementary water from this water source when the Minister announces that supplementary water is available, at such a rate as the Minister announces and subject to the conditions of their licence.
