Various categories/ subcategories of access licence

PURSUANT to section 59 (1) (a) of the *Water Management Act 2000*, I, DAVID HARRISS, having delegated authority from the Minister for Water, do, by this Order, make a determination as to the availability of water in relation to the water sources specified in Schedule 1, for the categories and subcategories of access licence specified in Schedules 2 and 3, on the terms specified in Schedules 2 and 3.

This Order takes effect on the 1st July 2009.

SCHEDULE 1

This Order applies to the:

1. Wybong Creek Water Source (as defined in the *Water Sharing Plan for the Wybong Creek Water Source 2003*); *

and to the following water sources as defined in the *Water Sharing Plan for the Bellinger River Area Unregulated and Alluvial Water Sources 2008*:

2. Bellinger River Water Source;
3. Boggy Creek Water Source;
4. Coastal Bellinger Water Source;
5. Coastal Kalang Water Source;

6. Dalhousie Creek Water Source;
7. Hydes Creek Water Source;
8. Kalang River Water Source;
9. Never Never Creek Water Source;
10. Rosewood Creek Water Source;
11. Spicketts Creek Water Source; and
12. Thora - North Arm Bellinger River Water Source.

Note: The water source(s) marked with an asterix “*” have an order in force under section 49A of the Act (previously section 60 (2) of the *Water Management Act 2000*).
